MISSION PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1 – Attend a KCSR Member Orientation meeting
- 2 – Apply for a DEM number through the Kittitas County Sheriff’s Office
- 3 – Fulfill Basic Training Requirements (See "Training Outline". Your DEM number will be issued upon completion of training).
- 4 – Complete additional training requirements specific to your operational group(s) of choice – see "KCSR Standards"

TRAINING OUTLINE

Search Personnel Levels

Base Camp Personnel	Shall be physically capable of performing their job and have adequate training to perform their assigned task within the base of operation.
Basic Field Personnel	Capable of searching an urban setting, where normal urban services are readily available and will not have to stay out overnight.
Intermediate Field Personnel	Capable of working in a wilderness setting, staying out overnight, under moderate terrain and weather conditions.
Advanced Field Personnel	Have demonstrated a high level of physical conditioning for a sustained or prolonged effort. Be capable of working in wilderness settings with weather and terrain extremes. <i>**Does not include technical rescue situations.</i>
